Preschool Uniform: We were considering moving to a P.E. uniform for the preschool students (sweats and t-shirts). However, due to the lack of small sizes for P.E. items, we are going to continue to have preschool students wear the regular uniform. Please note, they will get dirty. Girls do not have to have the jumper, they can alternately wear the polo shirt with gray shorts or pants. Supplies are limited, but we will be selling used uniform items on the morning of August 5.

Preschool Supply List
